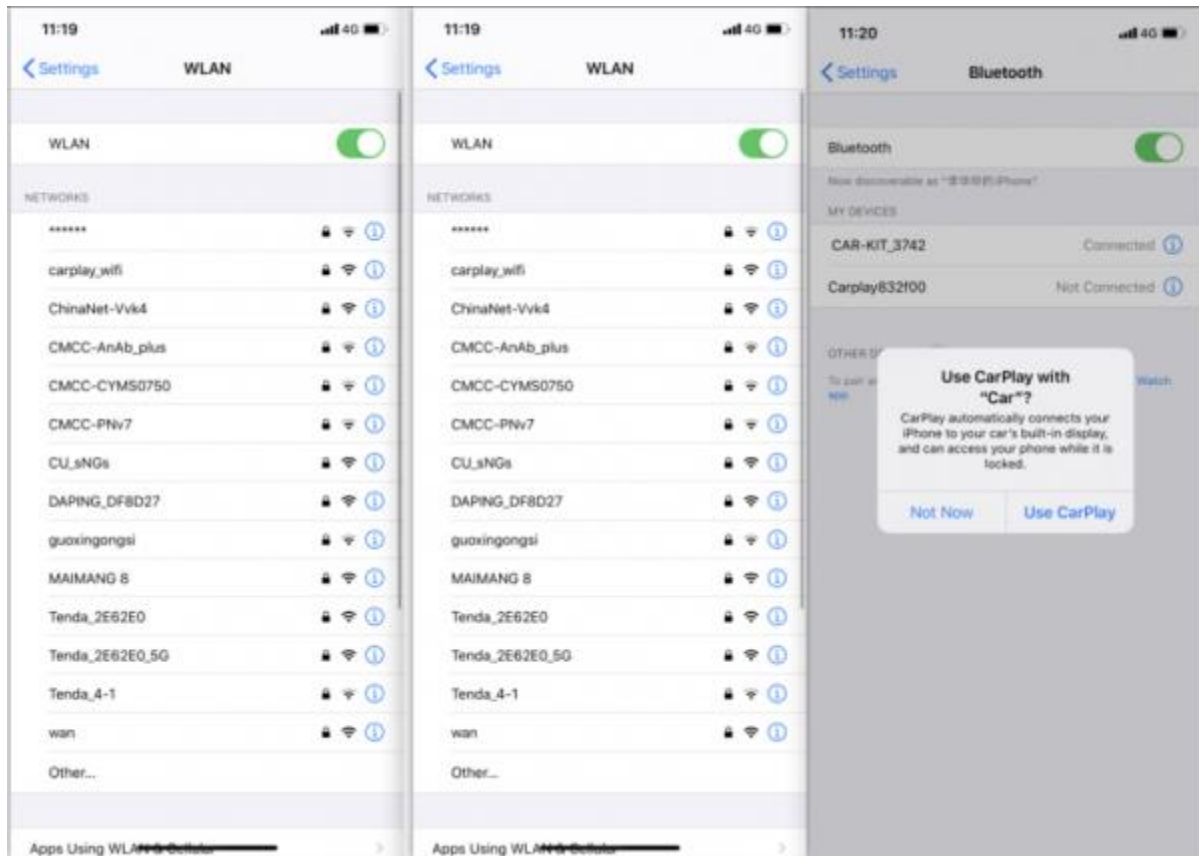


Carplay/Android Auto Head Unit FAQ



1. Wireless carplay connection steps

- 1) Turn on Wi-Fi.
- 2) Turn on Bluetooth and connect carplay's Bluetooth 'Car-KIT_3742'.
- 3) After Bluetooth connection is completed, the following prompt will pop up, then click 'Use carplay'.



2. Wired Android auto connection

- 1) Download Android auto APP authorized by Google on your phone.
- 2) Connect your phone to the USB port via USB cable.
- 3) Click 'Android auto' icon on your screen.
- 4) Click 'Reconnect', then Android auto will be connected and enter Android auto interface.

3. Supported audio and video formats

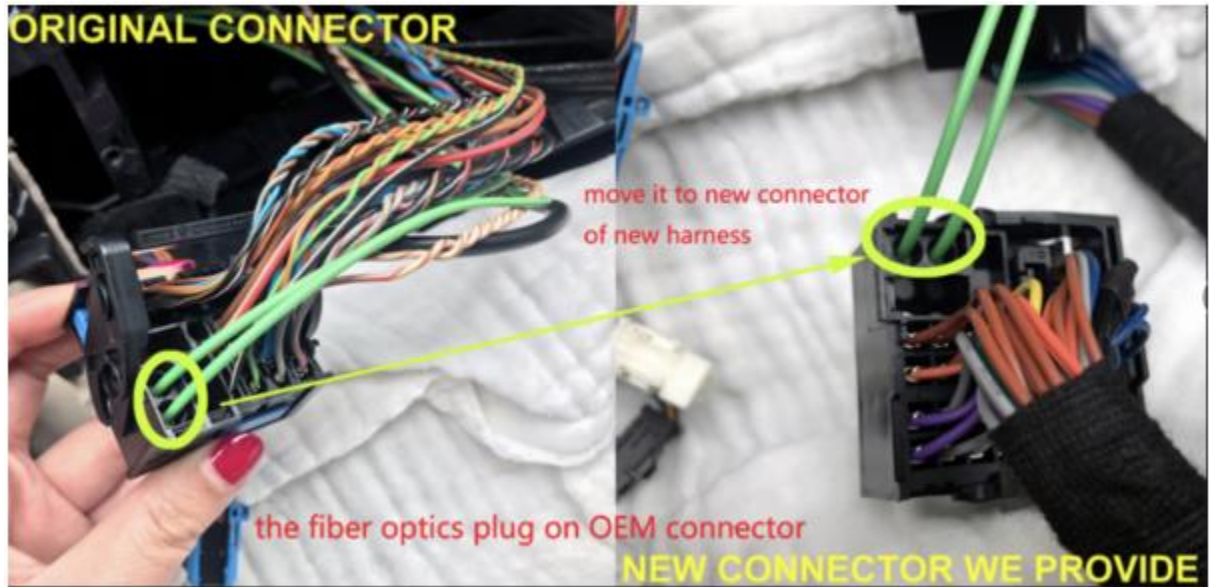
Audio format support : MP3, WMA

Video format support: MP4, AVI, MPG, 3GP,FLV, MOV,MKV

- Note: 1) All files must be in the root directory of the USB flash drive
 2) The USB flash drive cannot contain folders

4. No sound in Carplay system

2. Make sure if fiber cable is connected well.



3. If there is still no sound, you need to connect AUX cable to get sound.

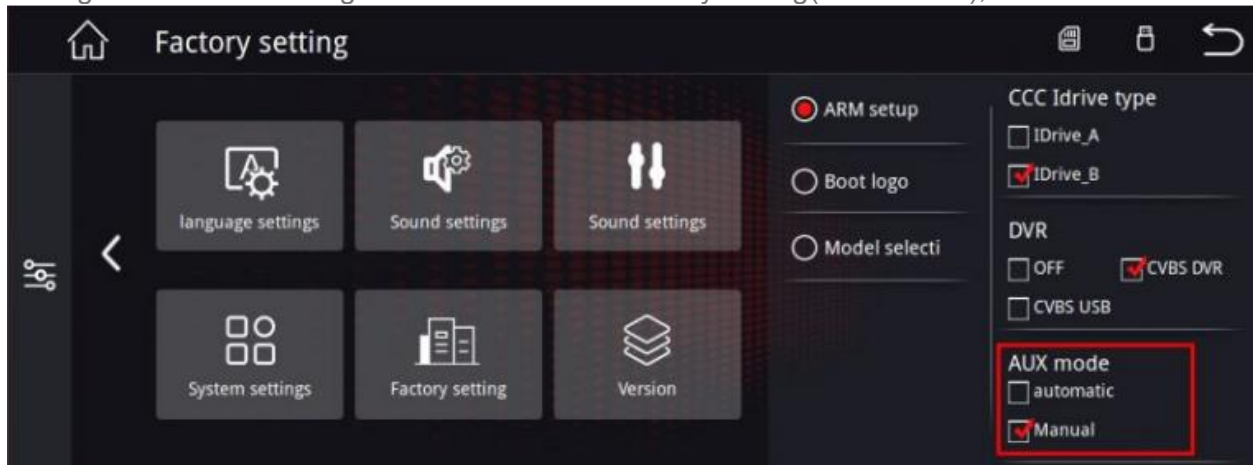


3) At the OEM system select AUX function

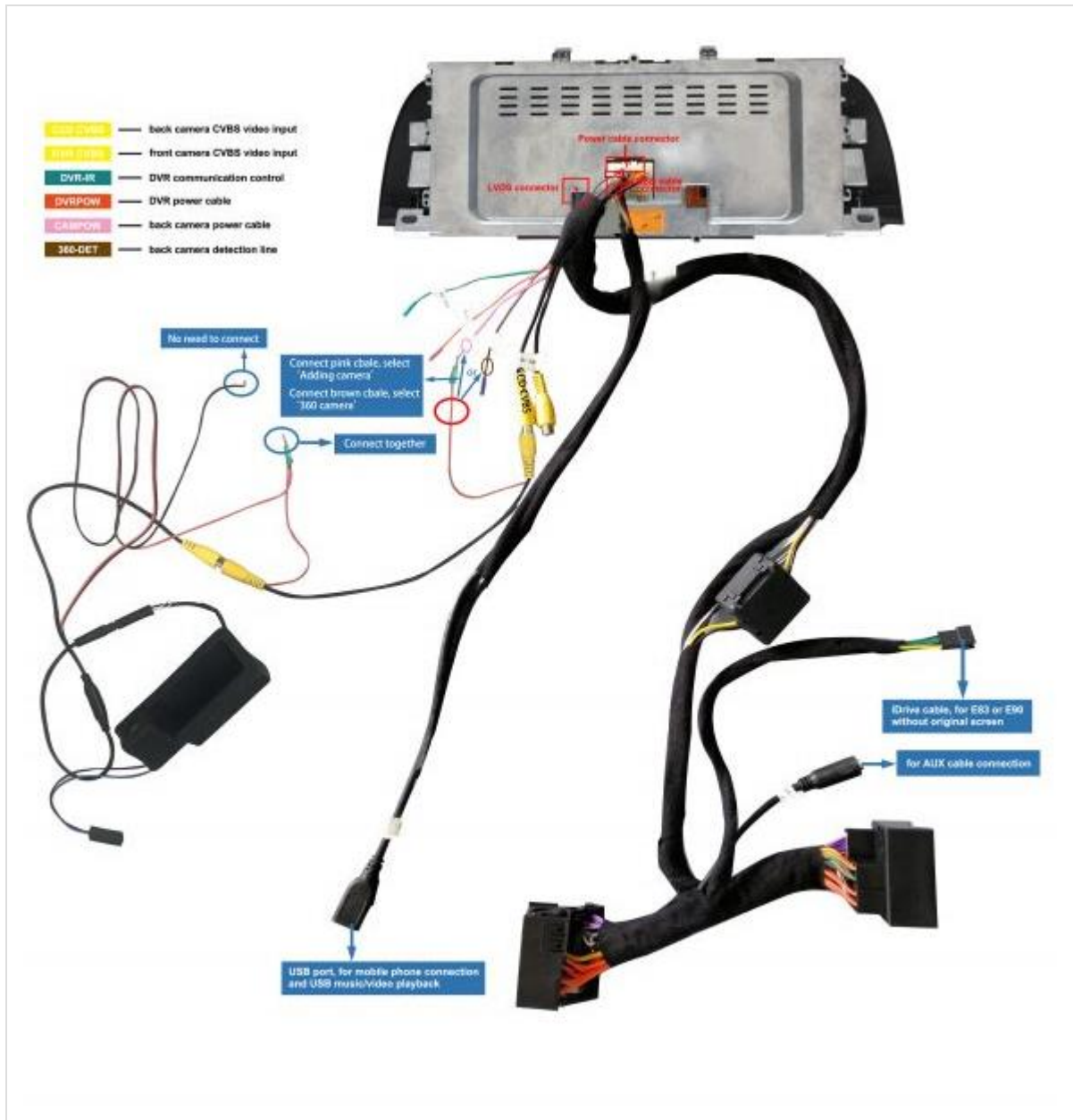


4. The sound will switch to OEM system when playing music in Android system

Change the AUX switching mode to 'Manual' in factory setting(PWD: 1368), then restart.

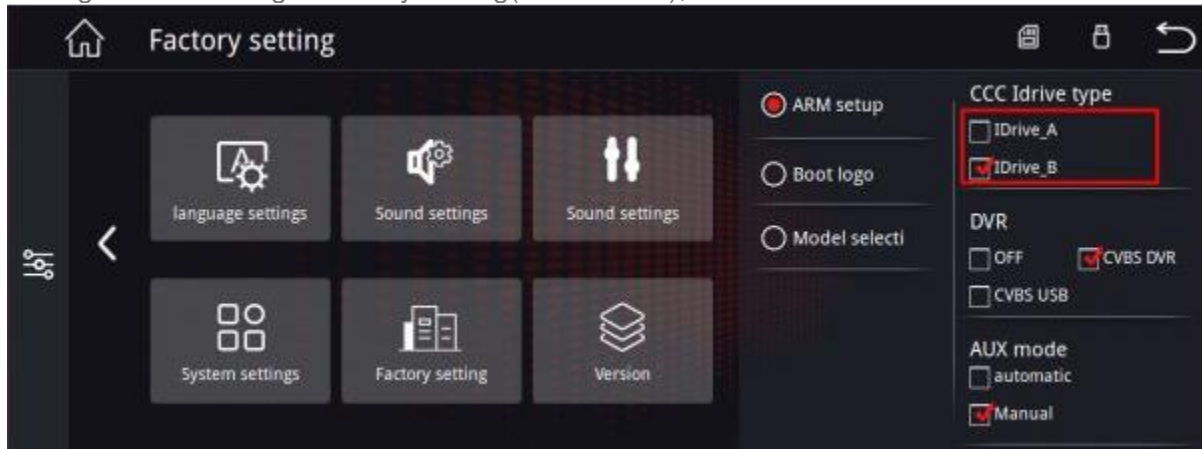


5. How to connect reverse camera?



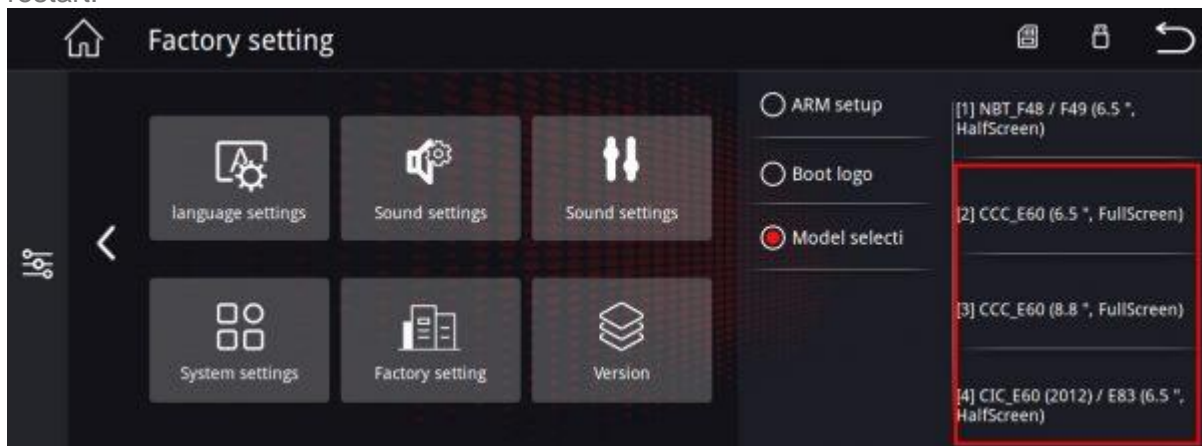
6. IDrive can't work well on Carplay system

Change iDrive setting in factory setting(PWD: 1368), then restart.



7. OEM system cannot display in full screen

Choose the same size as the original car screen to match in factory setting (PWD: 1368), then restart.
